The Power of Using Open-Ended Materials through Play for VPK Teachers and Paraprofessionals













Did your teaching team participate in professional development on Nov. 8th? Well, if you did not, you sure did miss out! Those who attended, received a wide range of strategies on how to use open-ended materials to promote creativity and scaffold play. Participants left with a better understanding of the importance of quality adult-child interactions and how they enhance the instructional delivery in the VPK classroom. Pre-K teachers were provided with **Open Ended Materials Parent Letter** to engage families in collecting recyclables and household items to be added to the learning environment. We hope that the information learned has become a natural part of your classroom supporting meaningful and authentic process learning. 
CLASS Foundations
