# Incoming Pre-K students Home Learning Activity

## Greetings,

We are so excited to have your child learning with us. Here are a few skills to help your child master before starting Pre-K.

#### Student must be fully potty train.

- Your child must know when they need to use the restroom.
- Your child must be able to unzip and zip their pants/skirt on their own, as well as button and unbutton them.
- Your child must be able to pull down and pull up their garment.
- Your child must be able to wipe/ clean themselves after each toilet use, without assistance.

#### Name

- Have your child be able to state their first and last name. Your child must know their first name.
- Have your child practice identifying their name (1<sup>st</sup> letter should be uppercase, all other letters should be in lowercase).
- Write your child's name along with other family members name on separate cards. Have your child select their name.
- Have your child practice writing their name. Work on writing their first name first.

### Colors

 Practice identify and stating the 9 colors: yellow, red, blue, green, orange, purple, brown, black, white.

#### **Numbers**

- Practice counting objects up to ten.
  - Example: How many are there, count and find out?
- Practice identifying and stating numbers up to 10.
  Example: What number is this? Find the number \_\_\_\_.

#### **Shapes**

o Practice identifying and stating the basic shapes: triangle, square rectangle, circle.

#### Scissor

- o Practice learning how to use a scissor: open, close, cutting process.
- Practice being able to cut along a line.

Have your child draw and write ever day.

Read and Talk to your child every day.
