PUBLIC HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT (PHCD)
OPENING OF THE SECTION 8 HOUSING CHOICE VOUCHER (HCV) PROGRAM
ONLINE APPLICATION SUBMISSION PROCESS

Notice is hereby given that Miami-Dade County Public Housing and Community Development (PHCD) will only be accepting online applications for its Section 8 Housing Choice Voucher (HCV) Program Waiting List, in accordance with regulations outlined by the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD).

The Section 8 Housing Choice Voucher (HCV) application submission process will begin on Monday, February 5, 2024, at 12:00 a.m. (Midnight) and will end on Monday February 19, 2024, at 11:59 p.m. No applications will be accepted before or after this period. The application will be available in English, Creole, and Spanish.

Applications will be accepted ONLINE ONLY at https://www.miamidadevoucher.myhousing.com or by utilizing the QR Code provided in this notice. Applications may be submitted via computer, tablet, smart phone, or any other device that connects to the internet. The online submission process allows people to apply at any time or place of convenience to them regardless of work schedule and eliminates the need to stand in long lines. NO PAPER APPLICATIONS WILL BE AVAILABLE OR ACCEPTED.

If you do not have internet access or a device to connect and submit the application and you need assistance with completing your online application, you may go to any of the locations listed below between February 5, 2024, and February 19, 2024, Monday through Friday, from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., except holidays, or you can call 311 for information or you can submit an application online at any time during the open online application submission period. You are encouraged to visit PHCD's website at https://www.miamidade.gov/housing for additional locations and/or information.

All applications completed and submitted during the open online application submission period will have the same opportunity to automatically be entered into a computer-generated randomization process, regardless of the date or time of submittal. Submission of an application does not guarantee placement on the Section 8 HCV waiting list. Only 5,000 applications will be selected for placement on this waiting list. At the time of selection, Applicant(s) must meet the program requirements and the income limits for the household composition established by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). The 2023 income limits are as follows:

PREFERENCES: Applicant(s) will be selected based on the following category of preferences: 1) Terminated due to Insufficient Funding by PHCD; 2) Displacement due to Natural Disaster; 3) Displacement due to Government Action; 4) Homeless; 5) Veterans; 6) Mainstream Preference; and 7) Miami-Dade County Residency Preference.

ONLY ONE (1) APPLICATION PER HOUSEHOLD WILL BE PERMITTED

Families who submit more than one (1) application or who make misleading or false statements will be disqualified. Families selected for the waiting list will receive notification from PHCD. No other notification will be made.

Reasonable Accommodation:
